



UPDATE: April 19, 2018 WYSL Board Meeting

Dear Club Presidents,

To ensure our clubs have as much time as possible to plan ahead for the upcoming fall season, I would like to inform you about **three** important resolutions passed by the WYSL board this past Thursday.

First pertains to our fall team registration fee schedule; due to the planned increases in our player and coaching insurance fees from **US Club Soccer**, along with the planned increases in referee and assigning fees, the following will be our registration fee schedule for WYSL travel teams for Fall 2018 – Spring 2019. Consistent with our policy of holding our registration fees constant over the span of three years, we expect to hold these fees stated below until fall 2021.

2 Season Fee:

U7- U8*	\$1,350.00	* (playing 7v7 in a dedicated division within the U9 age bracket)
U9 -U10	\$1,350.00	
U11 - U12	\$1,400.00	
U13 - U14	\$1,650.00	
U15^	\$1,900.00	^ (3 man referee system)

1 Season Fee:

U7 – U8*	\$710.00	* (playing 7v7 in a dedicated division within the U9 age bracket)
U9 - U10	\$710.00	
U11 - U12	\$750.00	
U13 - U14	\$825.00	
U15^	\$1,250.00	^ (3 man referee system)
HS JV / Varsity^	\$1,250.00	^ (3 man referee system)

Second, due to declining participation in our mini-festival 4 v 4 program for U8, we will **not** be offering this format on a league-wide basis going forward. We do intend to work with the clubs interested in continuing with this format to assist them in organizing U8 4 v 4 festival type games within their club and/or combining with neighboring club(s). We will continue to offer U7 and U8 teams the opportunity to **“play up”** within dedicated divisions under the U9 (7v7 rules).

Third, we are very excited to announce the WYSL will be initiating a pilot program for fall where individual laminated player passes will **no longer be required** at game check-in at league games for U7 – U14 age brackets. (U15 – HS varsity will still need to present separate player passes at check-in).

We have been working diligently with SIP / Sport Engine to include player images on the **Official Game Line-Up Card** and thereby eliminate the need for separate player passes.

More details will follow, but this is a significant step forward for the League, clubs and coaches. League produced laminated player passes will still be available for those teams traveling outside the League for tournaments and events that require separate

player passes, but we expect eliminating separate passes will significantly ease the logistical burden and costs associated with producing, managing and controlling over 10,000 player passes.
