Dear Graduating Senior:

In 2007, the Board of Directors of the Westchester Youth Soccer League (“WYSL”) established a scholarship fund to provide financial assistance to graduating high school seniors who have participated in the Westchester Youth Soccer League for at least five seasons.

In order to be considered, seniors must have achieved a minimum Academic Average of 80% and anticipate attending an accredited college or trade school. In addition, consideration for an award includes each candidate’s participation in voluntary and community service activities, as well as his or her financial need.

Guidelines

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible to apply for a Westchester Youth Soccer League Scholarship, all applicants must:

1. Be a graduating High School Senior the year of the application.
2. Have a minimum overall academic average of 80%.
3. Plan on attending a University, College or Trade School in the fall following graduation.
4. Have participated in the Westchester Youth Soccer League for at least five (5) seasons. Participation need not have been in successive seasons, but should include at least one season of participation during the applicant's junior or senior year of High School.
5. Have been involved in extracurricular school activities and/or community service.

APPLICATION: (SEE OTHER SIDE)

All applications must be completed and received no later than June 15, 2018. All applications will remain confidential and will only be reviewed by the WYSL Scholarship Committee.

CHECK LIST:

Before mailing your application, be certain that you have included the following:

1. Application.
2. Senior/Graduation Photo.
3. Two letters of recommendation.
4. Current transcript with SAT/ACT scores.
5. Brief resume.
6. Essay of 250 to 500 words on "How Soccer Has Affected or Influenced My Life."
